Topic: *Using GarageBand (now free) in the Music Classroom and creating a music portfolio using iBooks Author*

Description: This 2-hour hands-on session will share teaching ideas for using GarageBand for iOS (iPad) and OSX (Macintosh) with students. We will begin by creating a GarageBand piece on an iPad and then finishing that piece on a Mac to show how to share music across various devices.

We will also look at how to take student music and create music portfolios using iTunes and iBooks Author.

Requirements: If you are bringing an iPad, it should be using iOS 7 (the most recent update) and have GarageBand v2.0 installed. **NOTE: GarageBand is free through the App Store.**

If you are bringing a Mac, it should be running 10.9 (also known as Mavericks), which is required for the new version of GarageBand (**also free from the Mac App Store**).

Please note that installing GarageBand for either iPad or Mac should be done before you come to the workshop!
